# printmaking

## Workshop & Open Studio

Dates & Times: 4 Wednesday Evening 6:30-9:00pm  
(dates TBA)

Course Fee: \$100 + \$50 material fee = \$150

Location: Printmaking Studio, LAC lower level

Four classes will immerse the artist in the studio practice of intaglio printmaking through the introduction of both engraving and etching techniques. Digital image transfers / photo transfers will also be explored. Prints will be printed using an etching press.

## instructor

Local artist Marshall Heaton is excited to bring printmaking to the LAC's Printmaking Studio this winter. Through a series of four classes this workshops will allow artists to explore the art of relief printmaking (from its most basic stamping applications to specific focuses on woodblock and lino printing), and intaglio printmaking (from the etching to engraving process). Artists will hand-pull their own work and utilize an etching press, and learn about the art of multiples, editions, transfers, mono-printing and various post printing additive processes. Presentation of completed works; matting, framing, binding, photographing, exhibiting, and gifting will also be presented based on participant interest. Everyone is welcome.

- Sharpie markers (black, thin and thick)
- Specialty and other printing paper of your choice (optional)
