



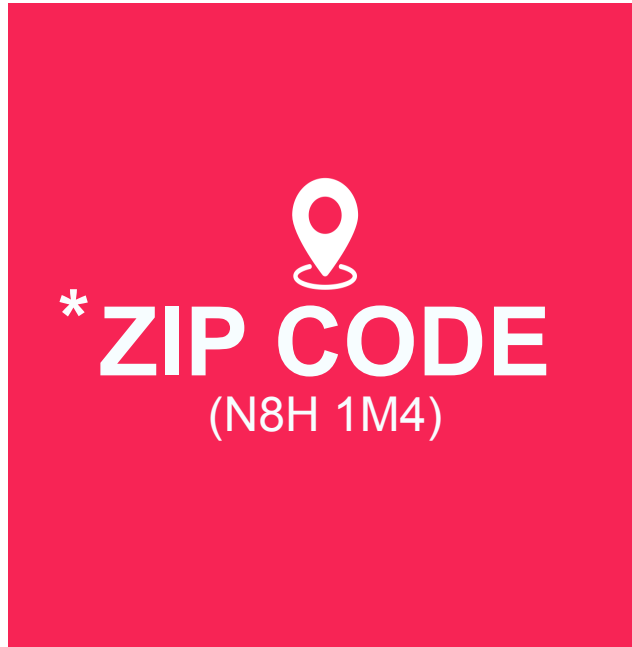
About + Mission

Zip Code is an exhibit of selected works from the region by guest curator Douglas Bedard (DKN Blues.) The exhibit's focus is to bring together a collection of efficacious works in a variety of mediums and subject matter throughout artist's careers.

About the Guest Curator

Douglas Bedard (DKN Blues) is regional artist based in Windsor, Ontario who holds an Honours B.A. in Art History from the University of Windsor.

From 1993 to 2011 Bedard curated 8 exhibitions and was the Curator from 2001 to 2002 at the Windsor Printmakers Forum.

Bedard has exhibited in 96 exhibitions throughout Southwest Ontario and Michigan with 11 solo exhibitions, including a two-person show at the Thames Art Gallery Chatham Ontario in 2002, a three-person show at the Glenhyrst Art Gallery in Brantford Ontario in 2004. Bedard was selected to participate in the Art Gallery of Windsor Biennial Juried Exhibition in 2001 and 2007. He was selected in 2013 by Aaron Timlin Director of CAID Contemporary Gallery in Detroit Michigan, for a small group show of 5. Bedard has participated in over 50 juried exhibitions winning several awards.

The Ontario Arts Council has supported his efforts with 6 grant awards. Bedard's work is in the permanent collection of the Thames Art Gallery, Chatham Ontario, The Leamington Arts Centre and several private collections in Canada, the United States and Kenya.

Eligibility

This exhibition is open to all visual artists located in Ontario and Michigan. (Not exclusively the N8H 1M4 region.) All mediums are accepted. This is a non-theme exhibit. Maximum of 2 entries per artist. All artwork must be originals and entirely executed by the applicant.

How to Submit

Submissions may be mailed or dropped off to the LAC on a clearly labelled CD/DVD, or emailed to: director@leamingtonartscentre.com. CD/DVD's will not be returned.

Please do not deliver or send the artwork for submission. Only those works selected will be requested for delivery. Incomplete or late submissions will not be considered. Submissions MUST include:

- Artist Statement (PDF or doc(x). format ONLY)
- Curriculum Vitae (PDF or doc. format ONLY)
- Two images of each work being submitted (150ppi jpg. digital format ONLY)
- Comprehensive Description of each image stating title, medium, price, year and size.
- Submission Form + Submission Fee (cash, cheque, debit, Visa or MasterCard)

Jurying

This is a juried exhibition. Only those works selected by the curators will be displayed in the exhibit.

**The LAC/SEAA reserves the right in its sole discretion to decline any work it feels does not meet the exhibition eligibility criteria or any artwork it feels is inappropriate for all audience and otherwise may be considered offensive or sexual in nature.*

Submission Fee

A non-refundable administration fee of \$13 for LAC members and \$15 for non-members will apply for each artwork entered. Methods of Payment: Cash, Cheque, Debit, Visa or MasterCard.

Selected Artwork Delivery & Pick Up

Only those works selected will be accepted for delivered on or before the delivery date listed in the schedule. Late artwork will not be accepted. Return shipping or pick up is the artist's responsibility. Artwork not collected within 6 months of the exhibit end will become the property of the LAC.

Hanging & Labelling

All works **MUST** be ready for display. Artwork not ready will not be accepted. Two-dimensional work **MUST** be securely **WIRED** on back. Alligator teeth style hooks are **NOT** acceptable. 3-D work that is free-standing must be stable. Installations and works requiring specific install must accompany diagram and description. All artwork must be clearly labelled on back with Name, Title, Medium and Sale Price using the included labels.

Sales

All sales will be handled by the LAC. A commission of 25% for LAC members and 30% for non-members will be collected on all sales.
