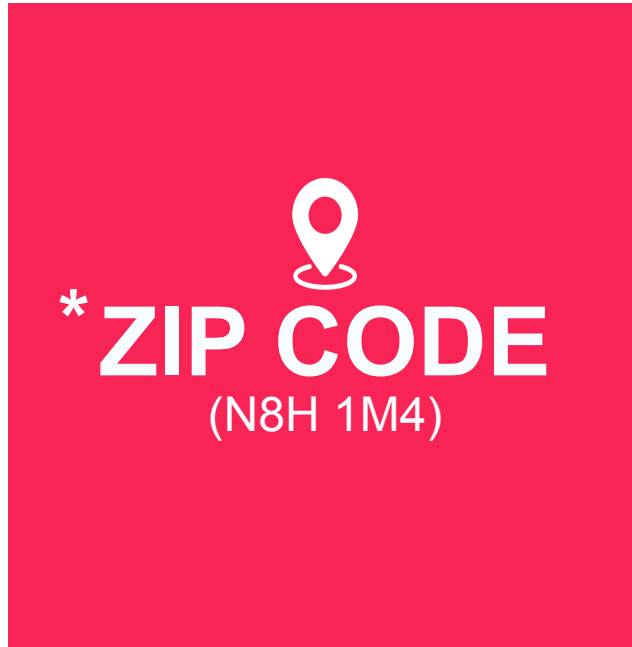

The exhibit's focus is to bring together a collection of efficacious works in a variety of mediums and subject matter throughout artist's careers. The LAC is proud to feature and welcome new exhibiting artists to the LAC and our region.

About the Guest Curator

Michael Karel Ondrovcik is a mixed-media assemblage sculptor, trained silversmith, blacksmith, woodworker and welder working out of Chatham, Canada. Ondrovcik's early influence was folk artist Sherman Burk, whose method of elemental reveal is foundational to Ondrovcik's process. Ondrovcik uses base minerals, elements, found objects and repurposed materials to expose their own innate experiential narratives of loss, sadness, and joy. Ondrovcik strips back the object, lets it speak, and builds its story to question the preconceived ideas, beliefs and detrimental practices in society.

Ondrovcik currently resides and practices art in the Chatham-Kent region.

Eligibility

This exhibition is open to all visual artists located in Ontario and Michigan. (Not exclusively the N8H 1M4 region.) All media is accepted. This is a non-theme exhibit. Maximum of 2 entries per artist. All artwork must be originals and entirely executed by the applicant.

How to Submit

Submissions may be mailed or dropped off to the LAC on a clearly labelled CD/DVD, or emailed to: director@leamingtonartscentre.com. CD/DVD's will not be returned. Please do not deliver or send the artwork for submission. Only those works selected will be requested for delivery. Incomplete or late submissions will not be considered. Submissions MUST include:

- Artist Statement (PDF or doc(x). format ONLY)
- Curriculum Vitae (PDF or doc(x). format ONLY)
- Two images of each work being submitted (150ppi jpg. digital format ONLY)
- Comprehensive Description of each image stating title, medium, price, year and size.
- Submission Form + Submission Fee (cash, cheque, debit, Visa or MasterCard)

Jurying

This is a juried exhibition. Only those works selected by the curators (Mike Ondrovcik and Chad Riley, LAC Director) will be displayed in the exhibit.

*The LAC/SEAA reserves the right in its sole discretion to decline any work it feels does not meet the exhibition eligibility criteria or any artwork it feels is inappropriate for all audience and otherwise may be considered offensive or sexual in nature.

Submission Fee

A non-refundable administration fee of \$13 for LAC members and \$15 for non-members will apply for each artwork entered. Methods of Payment: Cash, Cheque, Debit, Visa or MasterCard.

Selected Artwork Delivery & Pick Up

Only those works selected will be accepted for delivered on or before the delivery date listed in the schedule. Late artwork will not be accepted. Return shipping or pick up is the artist's responsibility. Artwork not collected within 6 months of the exhibit end will become the property of the LAC.

Hanging & Labelling

All works **MUST** be ready for display. Artwork not ready will not be accepted. Two-dimensional work **MUST** be securely **WIRED** on back. Alligator teeth style hooks are **NOT** acceptable. 3-D work that is free-standing must be stable. Installations and works requiring specific install must accompany diagram and description. All artwork must be clearly labelled on back with Name, Title, Medium and Sale Price such as the included example label.

Sales

All sales will be handled by the LAC. A commission of 25% for LAC members and 30% for non-members will be collected on all sales. If artwork is not for sale, mark NFS on the entry form and label.
