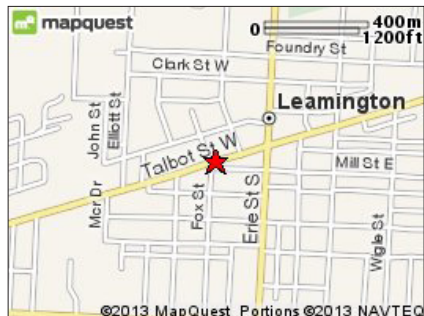

WHY EXHIBIT AT THE LAC?

- Low commission, 25% for members and 30% for non-members.
- Staff supervision Tuesday through Friday from 10am to 4:30pm, and Saturday from 12pm to 5pm.
- LAC provides many announcements for upcoming artist exhibition - LAC website, media releases, e-blasts, newsletters and social media posts
- Fully secured and protected with motion sensors and infrared camera surveillance.
- LAC and its contents are fully insured.
- Climate controlled and monitored.
- Fully accessible.
- Second floor offers meeting room for small gatherings, classes, seminars, workshops, meetings and more.

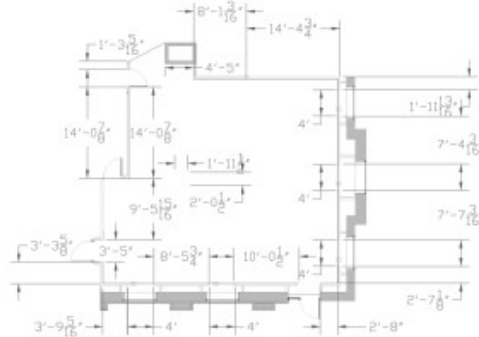
- Split Gallery (one space): \$145

Main Gallery 123 linear ft. / 924 sq. ft

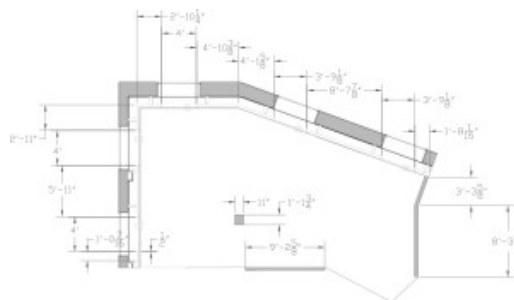


Split Gallery (1 space)

5. Artist statement must be in PDF or .doc(x) file format only.

EXHIBITION SELECTION

The Gallery Exhibition Committee for the Leamington Arts Centre meets several times a year to review artist's submission portfolios and selects candidates for exhibit at LAC (and/or other venues). Once the Exhibition Committee has reviewed your submission you will promptly receive a written response.
