December was a busy month with the continuation of A Signature Christmas: indoor artist market and the many preparations that come along with year-end. A lot of work was done preparing our updated website for our 2023 events and exhibitions while promoting new educational programming for 2023 as well as accepting submissions for the upcoming 8x10 Amateur Photo Contest, on display in January. December also meant the end of our calendar year memberships, so promotion/reminders for renewal was a priority.
